

TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR
THE 2008 - 2009 POLITICAL ACTION COMMITTEE

The Political Action Committee (PAC) shall:

1. Conform to the terms of the constitution of the ETFO Durham Teachers' Local.
2. Promote and enhance political activity and involvement by our membership in a wide variety of movements and organizations which advance the causes of social justice and public education.
3. Provide education to our membership around the issues of public education and social justice.
4. Work with teachers' unions around common political concerns and campaigns.
5. Produce and distribute materials to our membership around the issues of public education and social justice.
6. Establish and nurture links with organizations and community groups which advances programs and goals around the issues of public education and social justice similar to our own.
7. Whenever possible, support and endorse candidates running for public office who uphold the interests of public education and social justice.
8. Provide regular reports to the Executive and the membership and make available the minutes of all meetings of the PAC.
